

## **INFORMATION ABOUT PG D.M.L.T. COURSE**

1) **Duration** of the PG D.M.L.T. course is one year (Full Time)

2) **General :**

- a) PG D.M.L.T. is a full time course. Selected candidates will have to make their own arrangements for their lodging and boarding. The candidates will be selected either at merit /reservation and availability of seat at the time of interview.
- b) Applicants are required to pursue the progress of admission process by diligently observing notifications by the Dean, as displayed on Notice Board of the Dean, B.J. Government Medical College, Pune. and nowhere else. No individual letters will be written to applicant nor any correspondence in this matter will be entertained.

CANDIDATES SELECTED FOR PG DMLT COURSE SHOULD ACQUIRE COMPUTER LITERACY AND OBTAIN COMPUTER PROFICIENCY CERTIFICATE FROM APPROVED STANDARD COMPUTER EDUCATION INSTITUTES FAILING WHICH THEY WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO APPEAR FINAL PG DMLT EXAM OF MAARASTRA UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCE NASHIK.

3) **ELIGIBILITY :**

Candidates having passed B.Sc. degree course of Biochemistry, Chemistry, Microbiology, Botony , Zoology, Biotechnology and life Science as major (Principal) subject or BPMT or any other equivalent Health Science degree within the State of Maharashtra will be held eligible to apply. The candidate must be qualified and eligible on the date of submission of is application form.

4) **NUMBER OF ADMISSION :**

Only Sixteen candidates will be admitted to the PG D.M.L.T. course at BJGMC, Pune (With the State of Maharashtra only)

5) **RESERVATION :**

52 percent seats are kept reserved for backward class candidates and 10 percent seats kept reserved for EWS candidates as per rules in force.

Category wise distribution of total seats is shown in the enclosed cart.

**NOTE : The Backward Class candidates claiming the reserved seat, must submit the required certificates including Non \_ Creamy Layer and Caste Validity at the time submitting application failing which they will not to be considered for the benefits.**

**RESERVED CANDIDATES CAN COMPETE WITH OPEN MERIT CANDIDATES FOR OPEN SEATS ALSO, IF THEY STAND IN MERIT.**

5) **SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION S:**

1) Prescribed application form duly filled in all respects along with attested true copies of the certificates mentioned in the application form should be submitted in person in the Post -Graduate Students Section of B. J. Medical College, Pune time between 3.00.p.m. to 5.00 p.m. Only on all the working days on or before the stipulated date .

2) The candidates already holding any type of Job/Service must submit the application form through the management of the considered office/company/organization along with there No Objection certificate starting that the "If The Candidate is selected for the course he or she will be relived from the office/company/organization immediately to attend the full time course.

### 6. MERIT LISTS:

Two Merit lists will be prepared as follows:

- 1) First General Consolidates Merit lists will be prepared according to Corrected Total Marks obtained by them in S.Y. & T.Y.B.Sc. i.e. Chemistry or Biochemistry, Microbiology, Zoology any other equilent The Merit Lists will be displayed on the Notice Board of B.J. Government Medical College, Pune on the dates mentioned in the Admission Programme.

### 7. TIE:

In case of the candidate having highest total marks in S.Y. and T.Y. B.Sc. (taken together) will be placed above than the candidate who has obtain less total marks in S.Y. and T.Y. B.Sc. Exam.

In case tie still continues then the total marks of F.Y.,S.Y. and T.Y. B.Sc. will be taken into consideration and one who is having more marks will be given preference over the another who is having lower marks in these three examinations

### 8. OBJECTIONS ON MERIT LIST

Objections on merit list( if any) should be submitted in post graduates students section of this office in duplicate addressed to the Dean, BJ Govt.. Medical College Pune withn the stipulated period. late the objections will not be considered.

### 9. INTERVIEWS

INTERVIEWS WILL BE HELD ON THE DATE, TIME AND VENUE SPECIFIED IN THE ADVERTISEMENT ALL THE APPLICATANTS MUST REMAIN PRESENT FOR THE INTERVIEW AT THERE OWN COST FAILING WHICH THERE CLAIMS FOR THE SEATS WILL BE TREATED AS CANCALED AND THEN NEXT MERITED ELIGIBLE CANDIDATE WILL BE SELECTED. IF THE CANDIDATE ATTENDS THE INTERVIEW LATE OR AT THE END OF THE INTERVIEW, THEN HE /SHE WILL BE CONSIDERED ONLY IF ANY SEAT REMAINS VACANT IN SUCH CASES REPRESENTATION WILL NOT BE ENTERTAINED FROM THE CANDIDATES HIGER IN MERIT BUT REMAINED ABSENT FOR THE INTERVIEW OR ATTENDED THE INTERVIEW LATE.

## 15 PROSPECTUS OF PG D.M.L.T. COURSE :

The examination shall be held at the end of the for three subjects, i.e. Clinical Biochemistry, Microbiology and Pathology. To pass the examination, the candidate shall obtain in each subject 50% of marks in practical and theory separately.

Candidates with Pg D.M.L.T. qualification are expected to work as Technician in Laboratories attached to Hospitals under supervision of the senior officer like Bio-chemist, Microbiologist or Pathologist.

### **Following is the pattern work in Laboratories**

- Collection of samples of patients, registering and processing of samples recording and reporting of results.
- Use, care and maintenance of basic instruments and Glassware, in all the three laboratories.
- Preparation and preservation of various reagents.
- Analytic control programme for Laboratory.
- Safety precautions and first aid measures.  
In Microbiology Laboratory, identifications of various organisms preparation of different media, routine stool examination and identifying parasites and routine serological tests.
- In Biochemistry Laboratory – routine biochemical tests on blood and urine.
- In Pathology Laboratory – Section outing preparation of smears and different staining procedures.
- Preservation of viscera and their gross and Microscopic exam . routine hematology and work in blood bank.
